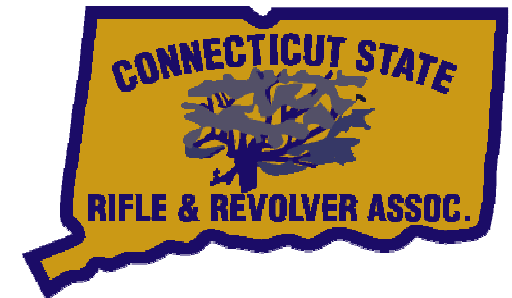

The *Connecticut State Rifle & Revolver Association, Pistol Division* is pleased to announce its 2010 OUTDOOR Pistol Match Schedule. This year we will be holding 3 NRA Registered 2700's, a Regional in May, and State Championship in September. All events will be held at the Alton S. Dinan Jr. Memorial Pistol Range in Wallingford.

Directions to Range: The Dinan Range is adjacent to the Blue Trail Range on 316 N Branford Rd. in Wallingford, CT. From I-91 take Exit 15 (Rt. 68). Travel east on Rt. 68 for 1.6 mile to N. Branford Rd. Go right onto N. Branford Rd. and travel 9/10ths of a mile. The range is on the left. Food is available at the Blue Trail Snack Bar.

Post Entries will be accepted if space is available. Advance registration is strongly suggested.

Eligibility: Competition is open to any member of the NRA. Membership cards may be checked. Entries will be accepted without an NRA membership number.

NRA Rules will govern throughout all matches. It is the competitors responsibility to be familiar with the NRA Pistol Rules.

NRA Classification system will be used in all matches. Classification cards may be checked. Assigned classifications may be used (NRA Rule 19.6).

Challenges: A \$2.00 fee will be charged for each challenge. If the competitor wins the challenge, the \$2.00 will be refunded.

Equipment: Competitors must furnish their own equipment and ammunition (NRA Rules 3.1 thru 3.18) and are responsible for its safekeeping. Triggers may be weighed and will be weighed if a National Record is broken. Eye & ear protection must be used by all competitors. Firearms for the Excellence In Competition Leg Match must conform to CMP rules. Competitors must furnish their own ammunition for the E.I.C. Leg Match which must be any safe ammunition in .45 cal. with a 230 grain, full metal jacket, round nose bullet or 9mm with a 115 through 125 grain full metal jacket, round nose bullet. Firearms and ammunition for the Distinguished Revolver Match must conform to current NRA rules.

Scoring: All competitors will be required to keep score for each other (NRA Rule 10.5). Plug type scoring gauges may only be used by Match Officials, Range Officers, Jury of Referee (NRA Rule 14.3.1).

Break times: 15 minutes between .22cal. and CF. 45 minutes between CF and .45 cal matches.

Awards: There will be one Open Winner in each match. There will be one award per four (4) competitors in each class, in all matches. If less than 4 competitors in a class those competitors will be moved to the next higher class. If after combining classes there are less than 4 competitors in a class those competitors will compete for open awards only. Team awards will be given on the same basis. Awards will be NRA Points, cash, trophies, plaques, medals or merchandise. Awards will be mailed with the match bulletin.
