

Skeet Opens Summer 2010, Plans Beginners' Day in May

Commissioner Bill Boehning reports that our winter 2009-2010 skeet season ended on April 11 -- which means that the skeet field is now available for open shooting all day on weekends, starting at 9 a.m., and on all weekdays.

In May the skeet community plans a Beginning Shooter Day to familiarize members with the operation of the skeet machines and offer instructional shooting skills. The times will be posted in the skeet house, on Lounge bulletin boards, and in the May newsletter as well as this website.

Keep in mind that the summer league starts in June; there will be a signup sheet in the skeet house and your early registration will help teams get organized. *The summer league is open to all members, spouses, sons, and daughters who can handle a shotgun.*

When you finish your shooting, you are required to refill the machines, make sure the motor is turned off with the toggle switch, and sweep off the broken targets from station 1 and station 7 -- the brooms are in both skeet houses.
